Students applying for *readmission* do not have to repeat any entrance exam. Only one nursing course failure/readmission to the nursing program is allowed.

<u>Students applying for transfer from another nursing program</u> must be eligible for readmission to their original program of nursing. Depending on reason for transfer, there may be only one admission (no opportunity for readmission) to the Elliott School of Nursing offered.
